Nam Nguyen, Vice Chair, WIN



In the 90s, Nam Nguyen and his family immigrated to Washington State as part of the Orderly Departure Program, a UNHCR initiative for South Vietnamese citizens. They settled in the suburb south of Seattle, where his dad is a retired administrator for a local community college and his mom retired as an administrator for a local hospital. Mr. Nguyen followed his dad into State service and is currently an Assistant Attorney General. Prior to working at the Attorney General's Office, Mr. Nguyen worked in private practice in Bellevue, WA and Houston, TX. He graduated from Boston University School of Law in 2010.

Currently, Mr. Nguyen is a commissioner on the Washington State Commission on Asian Pacific American Affairs. Mr. Nguyen was also a recent fellow of the Washington Leadership Institute, a University of Washington School of Law leadership training program for young attorneys.
